Re: Safety Data Sheets for Fresenius Kabi Canada Ltd. Products

This letter is to communicate to interested parties that pharmaceutical products and medical devices of the Fresenius Kabi Canada Ltd. portfolio do not legislatively require a Safety Data Sheet (herein referred to as "SDS") as defined under the Hazardous Products Act (HPA) and Hazardous Products Regulations (HPR) requirements of Canada. Such exemption is listed within the "Non-Application of Part II" of the Act.

In 2015, the Government of Canada published the <u>Hazardous Products Regulation (HPR)</u> which along with the amended <u>Hazardous Products Act (HPA)</u> updated the Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS). Under the WHMIS 2015 legislation, the following categories of products continue to be exempted from the requirement of the maintaining an SDS:

Consumer product (as defined in the Canada Consumer Product Safety Act); <u>Cosmetic, device, drug or food (as defined in the Food and Drugs Act)</u>; Explosive (as defined in the Explosives Act), Hazardous waste, Manufactured articles (as defined in the HPA); Nuclear substance, within the meaning of the Nuclear Safety and Control Act, that is radioactive; Pest control product (as defined in the Pest Control Products Act); Tobacco or tobacco products (as defined in the Tobacco and Vaping Products Act); Wood or product made of wood

The labelling pertinent to these products is covered under other legislative requirements, namely for drugs and medical devices, the Food and Drugs Act.

Fresenius Kabi Canada Ltd. is committed to continuously providing patients and healthcare professionals with the applicable and legislatively required handling requirements through the product labelling, in addition to concise and current information on the products and devices it sells as per the Food and Drugs Act of Canada. Product labelling is available for all products accordingly.
